- <u>Stony Creek Program</u> (Grades 1-9, alternative education where staff work collaboratively with families to support the homeschooling portion or with parent-designated community program providers to support assessment and programming)

- <u>Summer School</u> (for current and incoming high school students; students over age 18 are welcome)
