Dear Parents/Guardians of students of Connections For Learning,

RE: Notice of COVID-19 to Staff, Students and Visitors in Connections For Learning, 4300-43st, Stony Plain, AB

Two or more cases of COVID-19 have been confirmed at Connections For Learning, 4300-43st. As a result the Medical Officer of Health has declared a COVID-19 outbreak at Connections For Learning. Public Health staff are investigating to determine who may have been exposed at your school to cases of COVID-19 during their infectious period. The virus is passed from person to person by large, respiratory droplets, like from a cough or sneeze. This means that a person would need to have direct contact with droplets from a sick person or surfaces that they have recently touched. The risk of the general population in the school becoming infected because of these cases is low.
