





Traditional Home Education 2025-2026 Grant Funding Notification

As per Alberta Education, all families registered as Traditional Home Education are to be provided with no less than 50% of the funding allocation by Alberta Education. For the 2025-2026 school year, Connections for Learning is providing families with \$901.00 for students in grades 1-12 and \$450.50 for students in kindergarten. The Home Education grant offered to parents is intended to defray the costs of educating a student at home in the school year for which the grant is made available. The items that are submitted for claim must be directly related to supporting a student's program for the duration of that school year. Parkland School Division has a high degree of accountability to Alberta Education for the use of public funds to support education so guidelines will be followed closely.

We ask that all parents sign below indicating that they have been made aware of the funding available, and have been provided a copy of the reimbursement request form showing the guidelines set in place regarding reimbursement requests. Should you choose not to claim any funding, we ask that you initial in the box below indicating you have been made aware of the funding available and have elected not to submit any reimbursement requests for the 2025-2026 school year.
